Asimismo, critica la imposición de tributos, la esclavitud de los indios, se opone a la jerarquía eclesiástica, aprueba el bautismo masivo de los indios así como la imposición de otros sacramentos, y cree en la verdadera y auténtica conversión del indígena. Jerónimo de Mendieta (1525-1604). España. Nació en Vitoria en 1525. A los veinte años entró en la orden de los franciscanos y en 1554 se fue a México como evangelizador. Volvió a España en 1570 y regresó a América tres años más tarde para no volver nunca más a Europa.
