Vokaalia edeltävä konsonantti ei riimiparissa saa olla sama. Konsonantti voi puuttua ja niitä voi olla useampikin. Konsonanttiyhtymän tapauksessakin vokaalia edeltävä konsonantti on riimiparissa oltava erilainen, yhtymän muiden konsonanttien erilaisuudella ei ole merkitystä. Erisnimet alkavat isolla alkukirjaimella. Jos sana esiintyy sekä erisnimenä että yleisnimenä, molemmat on mainittu, vaikka tällainen identtinen riimipari ei täytäkään puhtaan riimin vaatimusta. Jos riimiryhmässä on verbi ja sen lisäksi sana jostakin muusta sanaluokasta, tällainen riimi on erityisen mielenkiintoinen ja se on sen vuoksi kirjassa vahvennettuna. Yksitavuiset riimit on järjestetty äänneasunsa mukaiseen järjestykseen, koska kirja on ajateltu ennemmin laululyyriikon kuin runoilijan apuvälineeksi. Sama sana saattaa esiintyä useampaan kertaan, koska se voidaan lyriikkamielessä tavuttaa monella tavalla. Yksitavuisien riimien listasta on pyritty tekemään mahdollisimman kattava. Mukaan on otettu myös murteellisia ja vieraskielisiä sanoja. Jos murteellisesta sanasta puuttuu loppuosa, sanan lopussa on heittomerkki. Sanat, jotka äännetään eri tavalla kuin kirjoitetaan, ovat listassa kursivoituina. Nämä ovat kuitenkin listassa äänneasunsa mukaisessa paikassa. Kaksitavuisien riimien lista pohjautuu suomen yleiskielen sanoihin. Lista ei ole juurikaan otettu murteellisia eikä vierasperäisiä sanoja mukaan. Lista on jaettu neljään lukuun tavunpituuksien perusteella: pitkä-pitkä, lyhyt-pitkä, pitkä-lyhyt ja lyhyt-lyhyt. Tavu on pitkä jos siinä on vähintään kaksi vokaalia tai sen viimeinen kirjain on L, M, N, R tai S.

It serves as a document of one of the world's many endangered languages.
